

Camp in a Box Health and Safety Precautions

Camp in a Box has been carefully planned to ensure the safety of participants while promoting fun in your own home! Camp in a Box will follow these guidelines to ensure safety and sanitization of supplies:

- 1. All supplies included in the box will be sanitized before going into the box.
- 2. The box containing all supplies will be sanitized prior to putting supplies inside.
- 3. A minimum number of staff will package the boxes.
- 4. All staff will be screened daily using the self-guided covid-19 screening tool.
- 5. Staff who package these boxes will be wearing gloves
- 6. Boxes will be delivered to the camper's doorstep, via contactless delivery.
- 7. The following week, a staff member will pick up the box and leftover supplies through a contactless pick-up system (i.e. please leave the box at the end of your driveway or doorstep).
- 8. Supplies that can be reused safely (i.e. magnifying glasses, scissors, etc.) will be sanitized for reuse. Supplies that cannot be cleaned safely will be thrown out if left in the box.
